DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1 – START FROM INDIA

➔ Report at your nearest airport 3 hrs prior to your flight timing to take flight to Siem Reap.

Overnight on transit.

DAY 2 – REACH SIEM REAP – TRANSFER TO HOTEL

- ☒ Reach Siem Reap in the daytime and get received by our representative at the airport. Traditional Khmer welcome at the airport and transfer to the hotel. Check in time is 14:00hrs and early check-in will be subject to availability and may charge an additional amount over the counter. In the

evening, we go to experience the traditional Apsara Dance at Cambodia which is a dance depiction of Cambodian cultural and historical stories.

- 📍 Dinner at Apsara Dance Theater

DAY 3 – FULL DAY SIEM REAP TOUR

- 📍 Breakfast in Hotel.
- 📍 Our guide will come and pick you up and take you for full day tour of Angkor Wat. The largest, best preserved, and most religiously significant of the Angkor temples, Angkor impresses visitors both by its sheer scale and beautifully proportioned layout, as well as the delicate artistry of its carvings. To approach the temple, first cross the vast moat, continuing along a broad causeway lined with naga balustrades. As you enter the main building, ascend through a series of galleries and courtyard before reaching the central sanctuary, which offers beautiful views back over the causeway and across the surrounding countryside.
- 📍 Continue your visit to Ta Prohm Temple. Unlike most of the other Angkor temples, Ta Prohm has been left just it was founded: the photogenic and atmospheric combination of trees growing out of the ruins and the jungle surroundings have made it one of Angkor's most popular temples with visitors.
- 📍 Visit the unique temple of Banteay Srei known as "Citadel of Woman" decorated with the deep carving of pink sandstone. Then continue inside the Banteay Srei temple also called "Women's Temple", and is known for training the female soldiers to fight back the enemy. The temple is constructed with very girly beautiful pink sandstone and stone carvings.
- 📍 Lunch at Local Restaurant
- 📍 Visit Angkor Thom which covers an area of 10 square km. Enclosed by a wall and wide moats; the city includes many of Angkor's most popular sights. Enter by the monumental SOUTH GATE over a causeway lined on either side by statues of demons and gods, each carrying a giant naga.
- 📍 Continue to the Terrace of the Elephants and the Terrace of the Lepper Kings, former spaces for public ceremonies, both adorned with dramatic bas reliefs. Visit the ruined Baphoun, royal enclosure and Phimeanakas before continuing to the mysterious Bayon Temple. In this temple, one of the most popular and compelling in Angkor, explore the galleries of beautifully preserved bas reliefs and ascend narrow stairs to reach the central sanctuary, where you will find giant stone faces smiling enigmatically down at you from every angle.

- 📍 Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

DAY 4 – KULEN MOUNTAIN TOUR – FLIGHT TO HANOI

- 📍 Breakfast in Hotel.
- 🚗 Check out from the hotel and our guide will come and pick you up and take you for tour of Kulen Mountain. Phnom Kulen National Park is located in Svay Leu District about 48 kilometres (30 mi) from the provincial town of Siem Reap and about 25 kilometres (16 mi) from Prasat Banteay Srey via Charles De Gaulle Road.
- 🚗 There are several nature features, historical places, and other sights making Kulen National Park an interesting place to visit. Its official name is Jayavarman-Norodom Phnom Kulen National Park. During the Khmer Empire the area was known as Mahendraparvata (the mountain of Great Indra) and was the place where King Jayavarman II had himself declared chakravartin (King of Kings), an act which is considered the foundation of the empire.
- 🚗 Continue onwards to The Thousand Linga River at Kbal Spean in the Kulen Mountain through a short hike through the tropical jungle where the former king of Khmer Empire purify himself with the holy water. Visit one of the most interesting sites at Phnom Kulen showcasing the massive reclining Buddha at Preah Ang Thom, a 16th century Buddhist monastery. It is a sacred site and pilgrims from all over Cambodia come here to worship.
- 📍 Lunch at Local Restaurant
- 🚗 We continue our trip towards the waterfall where if you wish, you can take a bath under the waterfall – it is quite an experience and a great photogenic moment too.
- 🚗 Later in the afternoon, transfer to the airport to take an onward flight to Hanoi. Reach Hanoi by night and transfer to your hotel.
- 📍 Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

DAY 5 - HANOI CITY TOUR

- 📍 Breakfast in Hotel
- 🚗 Morning visit the Incense Village near Hanoi. Quang Phu Cau Incense Village is a well-known check-in location on the outskirts of Hanoi with a traditional craft of making incense sticks that has been around for more than 100 years. You will get the chance to discover and learn about the cultural values of the traditional Vietnamese incense makers in addition to taking stunning pictures.

🕒 Lunch at Indian Restaurant

🚌 Afternoon Hanoi city tour starting with Temple of Literature - one of several temples in Vietnam which is dedicated to Confucius, sages and scholars. The Imperial Academy of the site, which was considered as the first university in Vietnam, opened for about 700 years and educated hundreds of well-known scholars and mandarins. Despite continuous wars and disasters, the Temple of Literature remained its precious architectural and cultural value.

🏛️ The Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum which serves as the resting place of Vietnamese revolutionary leader and President Ho Chi Minh. It is a large building located in the centre of Ba Dinh Square, where Ho, Chairman of the Worker's Party Of Vietnam read the Declaration of Independence on 2 September 1945, establishing the Democratic Republic of Vietnam.

🏠 Later in the evening, you can visit the famous Train Street of Hanoi and spend some time at one of the many cafes located there. (It is walking distance from your hotel)

DAY 6 – FULL DAY NINH BINH TOUR

🕒 Breakfast in Hotel

🚌 At 8 am, Our guide will meet you at your hotel and start a 120km bus journey through a verdant landscape. Arrive in Hoa Lu around 10:30am. Once the ancient capital of Vietnam dating back to the 11th century. Having been eroded over the millennia, the ruins have nearly been absorbed by the spectacular scenery creating a mystical atmosphere that will ensure to titillate your imagination, visit King Dinh and Le Temple

🕒 Lunch at Indian Restaurant

🏠 Later in the afternoon, board the sampan boats, owned by locals, gently sailing along Ngo Dong River, capturing the wonderful scenery of Karst hills, rice fields, and peaceful villages, and passing “Hang Ca”, “Hang Hai” and “Hang Ba”. Sail across the 3 caves and get mesmerized by the natural beauty of Ninh Binh often known as “Ha Long Bay on Land”.

DAY 7 – HA LONG BAY OVERNIGHT CRUISE

📍 Breakfast in Hotel

Start your journey to the World Unesco site of HaLong Bay. Arrive at the jetty in Ha Long City towards noon and proceed with boarding. Be welcomed onboard and lunch will be served while cruising towards the bay.

Embark on a **5–6 hour cruise** along the famous **2-day sleeper boat route**, passing through striking and uninhabited limestone islets such as **Cock Fighting** and **Thumb Islets**, named for their unique shapes. Enjoy a **Vietnamese lunch** served on board as you sail through the emerald waters.

Arrive at **Bo Hon Archipelago**. Highlights include (The program of each ship may vary as per their own schedule):

- **Visit Sung Sot Cave (Surprising Cave)** to admire dramatic stalactites and stalagmites.
- **Kayaking or bamboo boat** experience in **Luon Cave**, exploring the serene lagoon surrounded by limestone cliffs.
- **Titop Island**: Relax on the sandy beach or climb to the **summit of Titov Peak** for panoramic views over Halong Bay.

Return to the cruise to relax on the **sundeck**, enjoy the scenery, and share memorable moments with fellow travelers.

DAY 8 – HA LONG BAY TO HANOI – FLIGHT TO DA NANG

📍 Breakfast on Cruise

- ✚ We will continue our journey on Halong Bay in the early morning. A Tai Chi Class on the sun deck is a must that you should not miss when on the cruise.
- ✚ Sitting on the upper deck; you can relax, sightseeing while taking photos of the magnificent beauty of the rocky islands rising from the emerald water of the bay.
- ✚ Take part in cruise activities such as kayaking/ basket boat/visiting the cave or just relaxing (activities depending on each boat's itinerary)
- 🌟 Brunch on Board
- ✚ Start your return journey from Ha Long Bay to Hanoi around 11am. Reach Hanoi by late afternoon and transfer to the airport to take flight to Da Nang.
- ✚ Reach Da Nang by late evening/night and transfer to your hotel.
- 🌟 Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

DAY 9 – DA NANG & HOI AN TOUR

- 🌟 Breakfast at the hotel.
- ✚ Spend a leisurely morning at Da Nang. You can go to the beach to enjoy a swim or simply relax.
- ✚ Later in the day, visit Linh Ung Pagoda – situated on Son Tra Peninsula, 639 meters above the sea level and 10 kilometers away from the centre of Da Nang city to the Northeast. The pagoda faces the peninsula, overlooking the East Sea. There is Cu Lao Cham Island to the left of the pagoda and a spectacular view of Hai Van Mountain to the right
- 🌟 Lunch in Indian Restaurant
- ✚ After lunch, visit Marble Mountain, discover the stunning natural caves, the mysterious pagodas and enjoy the beautiful view from the top.
- ✚ In the evening, Move to Hoi An ancient town, visit the Japanese Covered Bridge, Sa Huynh Cultural Museum, and Ancient House... walk around lantern street, and shop at local market. Take a boat ride where you can float paper candle on the river for good luck.
- 🌟 Dinner at a Local Restaurant at Hoi An

Overnight at DaNang.

DAY 10 – FULL DAY BA NA HILLS TOUR

- 🌟 Breakfast in Hotel.
- ✚ Meet your guide and driver to head to Ba Na Hills. Take a cable car ride from Ba Na Hills station, and stop at Night station to visit Vong Nguyet Hills, Linh Ung Pagoda, and The Old Villas of French. Continue moving up by cable car to the Nui Chua Mountain - the top of Ba Na range,

visiting Nghinh Phong top, Le Nim Villas, Orchid Garden... Experience the hill climbing train (the first and unique funicular in Vietnam) and visit an old French cellar (Debay Ancient Wine Cellar) and flower garden Le Jardin D'amour.

- 📍 Lunch at Buffet Restaurant at Bana Hills
- 🏠 You should not miss walking on the famous Golden Bridge hanging in the foggy hills of the mountain, witnessing the amazing and gorgeous view of Da Nang City.
- 🏠 In the afternoon, free to join games in Fantasy Park - the third biggest indoor games zone in Vietnam with a series of interesting games: 4 - 5D film, skiver, The death race, dinosaur park.
- 🏠 Return to Da Nang by evening.
- 📍 Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

DAY 11 – DA NANG TO HO CHI MINH CITY – CU CHI TUNNEL TOUR

- 📍 Breakfast in Hotel.
- 🏠 Transfer to DaNang airport as per your flight timing to take flight to Ho Chi Minh City.
- 📍 Lunch at local restaurant
- 🏠 Later in the afternoon, depart for exploring the Cu Chi tunnels. You will have a short introduction about how the tunnels were constructed and how the people survived in the harsh conditions of wartime. Then, spend your time exploring the remaining area and tunnel systems which included the specially constructed living areas with kitchens, and bedrooms side by side with other martial facilities like storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, and command centers helping whoever lives inside the tunnels meet their basic needs. Besides, there are also many hidden trap doors and dangerous traps within the maze-like tunnels for security purposes during the war
- 🏠 Return to HoChiMinh City by evening and you can spend time at the Bui Vien Walking Street if you wish to enjoy the nightlife at Vietnam. The street is full of bars and pubs at either side with loud music and party vibe.
- 📍 Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

Overnight at Ho Chi Minh City.



DAY 12 – MEKONG DELTA TOUR - RETURN FLIGHT TO INDIA

- ☘ Breakfast in Hotel.
- 🚗 Check out of your hotel and start your journey to the countryside of Southern Vietnam. Today, we will visit the rice bowl of Vietnam – The Mekong Delta. Leaving the hustle and bustle of Ho Chi Minh City and starting your trip to depart for My Tho, the town lies on the left side of the Mekong River.
- 🚗 Upon arrival, board the motorized boat and cruise down the river around the four beautiful islands known as Dragon, Unicorn, Phoenix, and Tortoise Islands. Stop over at Unicorn Island, go walking around the country lane and see orchards, and enjoy tropical fruits, and folk song music performed by the local people. Visit the fruit plantation.
- ☘ Lunch at a Local Restaurant at Mekong Delta
- 🚗 Ride a hand-rowed sampan through the Thoi Son canal and treat yourself to the beauty of the countryside, visit the family business, visit the honey-bee farm, and enjoy a honey tea and coconut candy workshop. Later in the day, go by xe loi (local tuk-tuk) around the village and meet the local villagers to experience the local daily life in the Mekong Delta.
- 🚗 Later in the afternoon, return to Ho Chi Minh City and visit the Central Post Office and the Notre Dame Cathedral before you are transferred to the airport to take your return flight to India.
