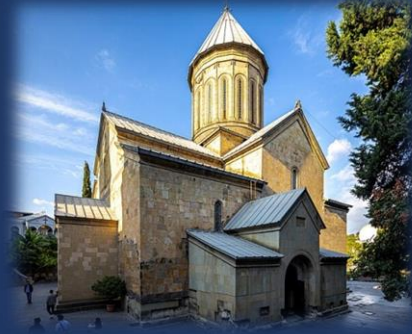
DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1 - WELCOME TO TBILISI

- ➔ Arrival at Airport.
- 🚗 Transfer from Airport to the Hotel.
- 🏠 Accommodation in hotel. Free time. **Overnight at Tbilisi**

DAY 2 – TBILISI CITY TOUR

- 🍳 Breakfast in Hotel
- 🚗 Go for Tbilisi City Tour. Start with the world largest orthodox **Holy Trinity cathedral**, Continue to **Metekhi church** and **monument to Vakhtang Gorgasali**, the legendary founder of Tbilisi. Walk down to the district of Sulfur bath houses passing by the only mosque in Tbilisi. Stroll through the Sharden area full of narrow streets with cozy cafés, wine tasting bars, souvenir shops, and breathe in the living past.
- 🚗 Visit **Sioni Cathedral**, **Anchiskhati basilica** and the clock tower of famous **Rezo Gabriadze Theatre**. Cross the Bridge of Peace to **Rike Park**. There we will take Cable car to **Narikala Fortress**. The best place to release adrenaline, dopamine, oxytocin, serotonin, endorphins and just feel happy. Charge with emotions and unforgettable memories.
- 🚗 Visit **Mtatsminda park** - famous amusement park that overlooks the city Tbilisi - Breathtaking veiws to city center and funicular ride to Chronicles of Georgia - Famous sculpture in suburban area of Tbilisi - overlooking a Tbilisi water reservoir
- 🚗 **Back to hotel. Overnight at Tbilisi**



DAY 3 – GUDAURI AND KAZBEGI TOUR

- Breakfast in Hotel.
- 🚗 Check out from hotel
- 🚗 **Gudauri** is a small touristic settlement and ski mountain resort located at the altitude of 3,000m on the southern slopes of the Lesser Caucasus range of Georgia. Gudauri is situated 120 km from Tbilisi. You can reach it by the Georgian Military Road for about 2 hours by car. Once many well-known writers and poets such as: Alexander Griboedov, Alexander Pushkin, Mikhail Lermontov, Vladimir Mayakovsky and even Alexandre Dumas went dwelled by it.
- 🚗 **Ananuri Fortress** -situated on the foreland by the Aragvi River, not far from Zhinvali water reservoir and about 70km from Tbilisi, Georgia. It was built by the Dukes of Aragvi and its earliest parts date from the 13th century. The fortress is on the UNESCO Tentative list. The fortress consists of two fortifications joined by a crenulated curtain wall. The upper fortification with a large square tower, known as Sheupovari, is well-preserved. The lower fortification, with a round tower, is mostly in ruins.
- 🚗 Continue your journey towards Mt Kazbegi. In this route we can enjoy the dramatic scenery, crystal-clear air and indescribable grandeur of the mighty Caucasus Mountains. Vicinity of Stepantsminda is picturesque. There is a river Therghi running below the town, with snowed peaks of Caucasus rising among which the Mount Kazbek standing out, with its 5033m height. There are quite a few valley glaciers and forests, both deciduous and coniferous. Fresh mountain air and mineral springs of Stepantsminda are considered to be the main therapy for breathing or eating disorders. (If the road is clear, then you can hire a separate 4x4 vehicle to visit the Gergeti Trinity Church).
- 🚗 Back to hotel. Overnight stay at **Tbilisi**.



DAY 4 – KHAKETI REGION TOUR

- ☛ Breakfast in Hotel
- ☛ **Kakheti** is a region of Georgia that shares borders with both the Russian Federation to the north and Azerbaijan to the east and the south. Famous for its monument from different time periods and diverse nature where you can see ancient architectural monuments and impressive fortresses. In addition to its fascinating history, Kakheti is also Georgia's premiere wine growing region and hence the trip won't be completed without wine tasting.
- ☛ **Signaghi** is a small town with the best view of the Alazani Valley and the Greater Caucasus Range. Thanks to the round-the-clock wedding palace, Signaghi has become famous as a "City of love".
- ☛ **Bodbe Convent** which is popular and sacred place situated in the peaceful & picturesque location.
- ☛ **Ujarma Castle** is an historic site overlooking river Lori and Gombori Pass.
- ☛ Back to hotel. Overnight stay at **Tbilisi**.



DAY 5 – TBILISI – PROMETHEUS – MARTVELLI - BATUMI

- ☛ Breakfast in Hotel.
- ☛ Check out from hotel
- ☛ Start the journey from Tbilisi towards **Prometheus Caves**. Visit the underworld in the Prometheus cave, where hundreds of stalactites hang from the ceilings, powerful stalagmites grow from the ground, and all this is illuminated by multi-colored spotlights. Six spectacular halls full of stalactites, stalagmites, and underground waterfalls, lakes, and rivers await you for a 45-minute long walk in the mysterious atmosphere of the cave.
- ☛ Reach Martvili and explore **Martvili Canyon** which offers a splendid and unique environment. It is 2400 m in length and 20-40 m in depth with a 12 meter high waterfall in the middle of the canyon. On the way we will pass local villages with the eye-catching charming yards typical only to this area. Take a small boat trip inside the Canyon, see one of the nature's most wonderful creations – waterfall. Entering the gorge's another side, we will stroll over the canyon's waters watching it changing its colors on every turn and stone. This is truly one of the best places for selfies!
- ☛ Continue your journey onwards to Batumi. Reach Batumi by late evening and check in to your hotel.
- ☛ Overnight stay at **Batumi**.



DAY 6 – BATUMI BOTANICAL GARDEN AND CITY TOUR

- Breakfast in Hotel.
- 🚗 Drive to **Batumi Botanical Garden**. Boasting one of the widest varieties of flora in the world, Batumi Botanical Garden was established in 1912 by the prominent botanist and geographer Andrey Krasnov. The garden is 111 hectares and contains flora from nine phytogeographic areas.
- 🚗 **Piazza and St. Nicholas Church** - anyone visiting Batumi will sooner or later end up at the Piazza. The square is located in the heart of Batumi. Unlike several more pleasant parks in Batumi, chaotic traffic dominates the square. While you will be able to relax here, there are some sights around the square worth visiting. The one of the famous landmark dominating Piazza is St. Nicholas Church, which is still worth a visit.
- 🚗 **Seaside Park** – forms an important part of the urban landscape of Batumi. The park was constructed in several phases by central government initiative as infrastructure improvements, but is very much associated with strolling and leisurely enjoyment in the minds of Georgians.
- 🚗 **Miracle Park** – located in Batumi Boulevard. Park is an incredible family destination, which offers to residents and tourists' entertainment activities like: yacht club, ferries wheel, souvenir shops, a romantic statue coffee for two in the park, to rotating statue "Ali and Nino".
- 🚗 **Statue "Ali and Nino"** – which is located in the "Miracle Park", invites every tourist to the show. It's a mechanical statue about love were Ali and Nino merge into each other.
- 🚗 **Boulevard** – This large boulevard is one of the longest in Batumi. But it is also one of the most luxurious! The most famous places can be found there: statue Ali and Nino, Bamboo square, fountains, summer theater, zoo corner and more. The best moment to walk in the Batumi Boulevard is an evening while it is all illuminated. That is definitely the best way to enjoy the "most famous boulevard in Batumi".
- 🚗 **Back to hotel. Overnight at Batumi.**



DAY 7 – GORI AND UPLISTIKHE TOUR – DEPARTURE FROM TBILISI

- ☕ Breakfast in Hotel.
- 🚌 **Gori** is one of the important cities on the Silk Road and during the tour you will see museum of the Joseph Stalin. Georgia dedicated to the life of Joseph Stalin, the leader of the Soviet Union, who was born in Gori. The Museum retains its Soviet-era characteristics. The museum has three sections, all located in the town's central square. It was officially dedicated to Stalin in 1957. With the downfall of the Soviet Union and independence movement of Georgia, the museum was closed in 1989, but has since been reopened, and is a popular tourist attraction. You will see **Gori Fortress**, a strong fortification on a hill, from where a pleasant view of the city opens. The fortress survived for many centuries and destructions, today only the fortress walls remain.
- 🚌 **Uplistsikhe Cave Town-Fortress** is situated on a rocky massif in 15 km eastwards to town Gori on the left bank of the river Mtkvari.
- 🚌 **Kvatakhevi Monastery**: Kvatakhevi, also spelled Kvabtakhevi, was for a long time the main monastery in the Kartli region and the literary centre of eastern Georgia. Several books were written here in the Middle Ages, and many manuscripts were translated from Greek into Georgian. Today, the monastery impresses visitors with its picturesque location in the Lesser Caucasus, as well as the elaborately decorated facade of the main church and the varied architecture of the building complex Back to hotel.
- ➔ Drop to Airport as per your flight timing.

Round-trip flight reservation: A confirmed return flight ticket (To be done by travel agent)

Evidence of sufficient funds: Bank statements for the last six months showing sufficient funds to cover your stay

Income tax returns: Copies of your income tax returns for the previous three years (Sharing PAN & AADHAR Number is enough)

Invitation letter: If applicable, an invitation letter from a friend or family member residing in Georgia. (To be done by travel agent)

The visa issuing authority may request additional documents or information, or invite the applicant for an interview.
